Class Descriptions

Strokes/Maneuvers: Fine-tune your forward, turning and side strokes for maximum efficiency – learn to better control and move your boat. Individual review of strokes, and blending stroke techniques. Some experience/training expected.

Greenland Kayaking – Learn the Greenland Paddle and how to use it; class emphasis is on full range of Greenland-style strokes and braces; rolling with GP introduced. Paddles provided.

Edging, Balance & Currents – Learn to use the kayak edges for boat control, turning and maneuvers. Side strokes reviewed and balance exercises used to improve comfort and skills. Using these techniques in small currents will be practiced. Some experience/training expected.

Beginning Kayaking – For the novice or little-experienced – introduction to touring kayaks, forward stroke and turning strokes. Rescues and safety techniques demonstrated and encouraged to try.

Youth Kayaking – For kids 7-12; they’ll learn boat safety, the forward and turning strokes, plus rescues and lots of games!

Rolling – Learn and Practice the Eskimo Roll; a more efficient rescue!
